



By posting an opportunity for the 2022 Day of Caring, I understand the following:

- Day of Caring will be on Friday, September 16, 2022 – RAIN or SHINE – Project sites must have a contingency plan in the case of bad weather.
- Participants will arrive at approximately 9:30am following our United Way Day of Caring Breakfast. The breakfast and program will be at 8:00am at the Lakeside Villa in Halifax. All partner agencies are welcome and encouraged to attend the breakfast.
- Projects should go at minimum until 12pm and can vary from 2-4 hours in length.
- Lunch must be provided to the volunteers.
- United Way of Greater Plymouth County is not responsible for any injury that occurs at your agency.
- United Way will assist in matching projects to volunteers and will make every effort to send volunteers to your project. However, based on the number of volunteers signing up and outside circumstances, we cannot guarantee volunteers will be available for every project.

Agencies are encouraged to share a brief presentation about their program and United Way partnership as well as a tour of the facility during the Day of Caring.
