



Day of Caring Organization Project Guidelines

By posting an opportunity for the 2023 Day of Caring, I understand the following:

- Day of Caring will be on Monday, September 11, 2023 – RAIN or SHINE – Project sites must have a contingency plan in the case of bad weather.
- Volunteers will arrive to your site at approximately 9 am.
- Projects should go at minimum until 12pm and can vary in length. Most projects conclude by 2pm.
- Lunch must be provided to the volunteers.
- United Way of Greater Plymouth County is not responsible for any injury that occurs at your agency.
- United Way will assist in matching projects to volunteers and will make every effort to send volunteers to your project. However, based on the number of volunteers signing up and outside circumstances, we cannot guarantee volunteers will be available for each project.

Agencies are encouraged to share a brief presentation about their program and United Way partnership as well as a tour of the facility during the Day of Caring.
