We served a total of 822 households. 252 families were new to the center.








# 20,168 Calls for Help to United Way's Mass211

Of the **20,168** calls for help in greater Plymouth County, **9,000** these calls were pandemic related. This volume is more than double 2019 numbers!













### Established in April of 2020





assisted **151** families in the Brockton & Middleboro Early Intervention and Head Start programs to get **diapers, wipes, formula, disinfectant and groceries**.

#### **BAMSI**

Helpline responded to **urgent help calls** from residents who needed short term shelter, food assistance, diapers, cleaning products, rental assistance and personal hygiene products.

Dorn Davies Senior Center to distribute **food to seniors** in need.







#### **Here :** Beth Israel Deaconess Hospital- Plymouth

purchased needed PPE for their front line staff: **7,000** Isolation gowns, **5,000** Procedure masks, **1,250** Face shields and N95s.

#### **\*** Boys & Girls Club of Marshfield

purchased **masks**, **gloves**, **and disinfectant** to keep the club clean





# COVID-19 Response Fund Impact United Way

#### **H**Brockton Area Arc

helped **31 families** out of work and are taking care of children and family members who are **developmentally or physical disabled**.

#### **\*Brockton Day Nursery**

**20 families with young children** received gift cards from local grocery stores so that their low income families with limited means could buy groceries and cleaning supplies







#### **\*** Brockton Neighborhood Health Center

received funds to support COVID-19 vaccination program for residents of the Brockton Housing Authority. This effort will ensure that both older people, people with disabilities and people of diverse backgrounds will be able to be vaccinated.



#### **\*** Brockton Salvation Army

received additional funding for **125 families** to receive **nutritious food boxes.** 



#### **\*** Cardinal Cushing Centers

provided with sanitation supplies and personal protective equipment for staff as well as **100 students and adults with intellectual disabilities.** 

#### **\*** Catholic Charities South

received **food resources** to meet the increased demand of more than **350 households** at the pantry.





#### **\*** Cape Verdean Women United

received funding to purchase **grocery store gift cards** for families in need.


#### **\***The Charity Guild

received **food assistance and personal care items** for individuals and families.

received **grocery store gift cards** that were distributed to **20** families in need to access items such as food, baby formula, and cleaning supplies.

**130 homeless neighbors** each night were supplied with personal protective equipment, cleaning products, personal care and hygiene products.

provided **50** individuals with **30 days of food**.

helped families experiencing food insecurity with **bagged lunches and bus passes** for those in need of transportation.

purchased **grocery store gift cards** for **40 vulnerable students** who have lost their jobs, are single parents, veterans and/or students with disabilities.



#### **\*** Road to Responsibility

provided **sanitation and medical supplies** for **18** residential homes serving **77** individuals with **development and cognitive disabilities**.

#### 🔆 School on Wheels

provided **school supplies** to complete fully stocked, grade level backpacks to be distributed to **children facing homelessness**.

purchased **Personal Protective Equipment** (**PPE**) to help meet the extraordinary need during this crisis.


The Arc of Plymouth & Upper Cape purchased needed grocery store gift cards for families experiencing food insecurity.
