#### **EDUCATION**

Ericka, a 5-year-old preschool student, came to Brockton Day Nursery from a hard-working family that struggles to make ends meet. Ericka was able to receive a scholarship, funded by United Way of Greater Plymouth County, allowing her to attend the program where she recently graduated kindergarten as the valedictorian and gave a speech to more than 100 people. Due to the LIVE UNITED Fund, Ericka's future is bright and full of promise.

#### **HEALTH**

Rosie is a 60-year-old resident of Plymouth County who has been disabled for more than 20 years due to a progressive neurological disease. She requires a great deal of care and lives with her 90-year-old mother. Mom has made a commitment to care for her "child" at home. Brockton Visiting Nurse Association, a United Way-funded agency, provides home health aide services to offer personal care for Rosie and a needs assessment to ensure that she is safe and comfortable. The United Way's LIVE UNITED Fund helps Rosie (and her mother) enjoy a happy and healthy life together in the comfort of their own home.



#### **INCOME**

Unemployed and homeless, Bill was accepted into Father Bill's & MainSpring's WorkExpress program, a highly successful job-training initiative that receives significant funding from the United Way of Greater Plymouth County. After 10 months of intensive on-the-job coaching, personal counseling and lots of hard work, Bill not only obtained full-time employment but saved enough money to purchase a car and move into an apartment. Thanks to the United Way's LIVE UNITED Fund, Bill now enjoys a fulfilling, productive and independent life.
